



Application Process

- Student completes the application and submits a typed and signed essay of at least 150 words answering the question: *“Why do you want to attend Middle College High School and how will this impact your future goals?”* **The essay must be signed by the student.**
- Student requests a current transcript from his/her high school counselor’s office and attaches it with his/her essay and the Notarized Financial Agreement to the MCHS application and submits all original documents to the MCHS office no later than **April 25, 2025.**
- Student requests a recommendation from one teacher and from his/her high school counselor. Recommendation forms are available online with the application and are due to the MCHS office by **April 25, 2025.**
- Student must take the ACT no later than the April test date. You register for the test under your current high school. Once scores are received, send your ACT scores to the address below as soon as you receive notification. Please send a picture of the “View Your Scores” sheet on a desktop computer, from ACT with your first and last name showing and ACT scores showing on the page. Each test date and scores must be listed by test date, no superscores to middle.college@summerschool.org.
- Students who are accepted into the program **must** attend an Orientation Day specified in the acceptance letter. A parent or guardian is required to attend the orientation with the student.
