



Application Process

- Student completes the application and submits a typed and signed essay of at least 150 words answering the question: *“Why do you want to attend Middle College High School and how will this impact your future goals?”* **The essay must be signed by the student.**
- Student requests a current transcript from his/her high school counselor’s office and attaches it with his/her essay and the Notarized Financial Agreement to the MCHS application and submits all original documents to the MCHS office no later than **April 18, 2022**.
- Student requests a recommendation from one teacher and from his/her high school counselor. Recommendation forms are available online with the application and are due to the MCHS office by **April 18, 2022**.
- Student must take the ACT no later than the April test date. You register for the test under your current high school. Once scores are received, send a screen shot of the scores showing your name with composite score and sub-scores to middle.college@sumnerschools.org.
- Students who meet all criteria will be informed in late May of interview or lottery dates if there are more qualified applicants than available spots in the MCHS program.
- Students who are accepted into the program **must** attend an Orientation Day specified in the acceptance letter. A parent or guardian is required to attend the orientation with the student.
